- 2 Ingarfill's I A Gigalo of Anamericha Color Dreams, 9 month old, well marked bl/r/t dog. Not as balanced as 1 at this stage. Good eye & expression. Well laid shoulder & good upper arm. Deep chest, well sprung rib. Good turn of stifle & neat feet. Needs to go up in front to complete the picture. Positive mover, covering the ground well with plenty of enthusiasm.
- **PG** (1) 1 Harris' Harrisburg Little Princess, compact buff bitch. Pretty, well proportioned head. Plush muzzle. Good in back skull. Clean, reachy neck into well made front assembly. Short, strong back. Ribs well sprung. Correct tailset& carriage. A real showgirl, moving out with drive from firm, well placed hocks.
- **O** (6,3) 1 Palmer's Amemoria Diamond Jubilee, quality black dog, balanced with lovely head chiselling, broad, square muzzle. Lovely eye & expression. Plenty of bone & substance.
