My thanks go to the Society for inviting me to judge the breed and to the exhibitors for giving me the privilege of judging their dogs.

- J (1,0)** 1 **Davis's Digaden Fact Finder** - Thirteen month old bitch with tan head markings and spot at root of tail. Well presented friendly youngster, scissor bite, coat not yet at its best. Easily spannable and moved freely around the ring.
- PG (5,1)** 1 **Davis's Digaden Fact Finder** (see previous class).
2 **Hall's Frithgarth Magic Sandpiper** – Masculine white dog with darkest of eyes, scissor bite and lovely loose pelt but not in the best of coats today. Just spannable.
3 **Walls's Prima Donna Roxy Cool**
- O (5,1)** 1 **Collis's Riplington Black Cherry** –Tan Head markings with lovely character and expression. Scissor bite, nice neck and shoulders with the harshes of coats and loose pelt. Good topline with correct rise over loin and good tail set. Strong hindquarters complete a lovely balanced bitch who moves effortlessly around the ring. She is a pleasure to watch and looks like she will keep going all day **BOB**.
2 **Lewis's Cassacre Red Duster** Feminine Smooth Coated bitch with tan ears and patches over loin and at root of tail. Presented in good hard condition, with a lovely dense coat and loose pelt. Nice front, spannable and well muscled rear provides plenty of drive around the ring. Handled well for **RBOB**.
