Hungarian Wirehaired Vizsla - Junior: (1)

1st Spillane, Mr D & Mrs J, Belatarr Jupiter: Very smart and well-balanced dog of just 6 months. Moderately broad skull, broad nose, lovely eye, ears hanging close to cheeks, correct, clean and complete dentition, strong neck set neatly into well placed shoulders, well proportioned body, excellent quality bone all through, nice feet, moved very well. **BP. RBOB** and **Puppy Group 4**

Hungarian Wirehaired Vizsla - Open: (3)

1st Wand, Mrs A, Herlinga Hulda with Aswann: Balanced and medium size 3 year old bitch, well developed and slightly rounded skull, nose in harmony with coat colour, square muzzle, intelligent expression, dentition correct, clean and complete, strong neck into well placed shoulders and corresponding return of upper arm, elbows close to body, well developed chest, moderate rear angulation, movement was good but she reached another level in the Gundog Group where she was shortlisted and moved with a different handler. **BOB**

1st Draper, Mrs K, Quilesta Just Talented: Pleasing male, well proportioned head to body, Correct, clean and complete dentition, medium size eye giving intelligent expression. Excellent coat. Marginally steep in upper arm, good depth of brisket, too long cast in loin than I would have liked, my template calls for square, he was not. Moved well when settled. **BOB**

Clumber Spaniel - Junior: (1)

1st Grant, Mrs L, Tweedsmuir Chenoa At Windfly: 13 month bitch, large square head of medium length with clean eyes free from haw, vine-shaped clean ears, powerful neck, adequate bone all through, strong forequarters, deep chest and moderate body length, hocks low, stifle well bent and set straight, moved well, presented in fabulous condition.

Clumber Spaniel – Open: (5)

1st Monaghan, Mr & Mrs, SH CH Tweedsmuir Mikado: Well balanced and extremely well boned dog, head large and square but not overdone, deep stop and heavy brows, clean eyes free from haw, large vine-shaped clean ears, strong well placed shoulders and corresponding return of upper arm, deep chest, well sprung ribs, powerful hindquarters, stifles well bent hocks low. Moved very well and I was pleased to see him shortlisted in the Gundog Group. **BOB**

2nd Hirst, Miss E A & Mrs J M, Creeaark Artreyu: Pleasing and balanced bitch of 4 years, good head, deep stop, strong neck into well placed shoulders, deep chest, muscular loin, large round feet – she moved far better with her owner in the latter Reserve Best Of Breed Stakes where it was my pleasure to award her first from a substantial and quality entry. **RBOB**
