## **Cesky Terrier:**

**L** (3, 1) 1 Burrage's Komidion Prima Donna Of Sametova. Good length of head, clean arched skull, shoulders fine, straight front, elbows free, well ribbed moved out soundly.

2 Burrage & England's Shasgav Nothin Else Matters By Ashleyheath. Good spring of rib, good length in loin, hindquarters strong. A little wider in front and not the free movement of winner.

**O** (3, 2) 1 Burrage & England's Ch Asheleyheath's Black Thunder. BOB. Quality dog, ribs rounded and well back, strong in loin, powerful hindquarters, correct angulation giving sound movement coming and going. Lovely head shape, just enough stop, ears well set and carried close in. BOB.

## **SCOTTISH TERRIER:**

**J** (1) 1 Roe & Stewart's Eskwyre It's A Lot Like Love. Good length of head, strong muzzle, flattened skull, distinct stop, lovely eye shape, straight in front, elbows well in, deep ribbed, wide hindquarters, moved smartly. BOB.

## **Staffordshire Bull Terrier:**

**J** (4, 2) 1 Kirk's Jodanzac Fireball. Red. Liked this little red bitch, only 16 months and will strengthen in front. Balanced head, not too short in muzzle, good stop, broad in skull. Good lay of shoulder with elbows tight in, short strong coupling, well muscled hindquarters. BOB.

2 Yates' Ellchansa Happy Ever After. Sweet headed 8 month puppy, deep ribs and wide well developed hindquarters. Broad skull and good ear carriage.

## **AVNSC Terrier:**

**P** 1 Hayes' Ragus Seven Jumps. Norwich Terrier. Completely fell for this 7 month puppy, short back, deep ribs, straight in front, wide quarters, true on the move. Has a lovely eye and expression. Has the most superb temperament. Puppy Group winner.

**J** (2, 1) 1 Hayes' Ragus Seven Jumps. Norwich Terrier.

**PG** (3, 2) 1 Walls' Whistlewoods You Wear It Well (Imp Swe). JRT. Good size and balance. Good length of muzzle, lovely eye and expression. Would like a smaller ear and maybe a tab shorter in loin. Straight in front and true on the move. Good coat texture.

**O** (6, 4) 1 Jones' Perrisblu The Duke. Welsh Terrier. Lovely smart compact dog, strong muzzle, gentle stop, lovely eye, small and dark, straight front, lovely neck into shoulder, firm topline. Moved out ok.

2 Hayes' Ragus Fabulous Clown. Norwich Terrier. Carrying a little excess today, coupling a little long, deep through rib, well angulated and let down on hock.

**TERRIER GROUP:**

Atkin's Holbam Celtic Summer. Irish Terrier. Lovely balance to this Irish, good length of leg giving racy appearance. Strong in muzzle, super expression, strong neck, well layed into shoulder, well muscled hindquarters. Coat harsh and well presented.

**TERRIER PUPPY GROUP:**
