Grey brindle bitch with a nice dark eye. Good stop, well placed ears, lovely level topline, with correct tailset and a strong back end giving her super movement.

Limit 3 (0 Abs)

15 month old grey brindle bitch. A lot to like about this girl... Beautiful head, lovely expression, good neck into well placed shoulders. Straight front, level topline and great movement.

Lhasa Apso. Red male with strong head and dark eye. Straight front, level topline and strong hindquarters. Moved with drive.

Boston Terrier. A very pretty bitch with a lovely head and dark eye. Good reach of neck on a straight front and good pasterns. Well sprung ribs, lovely tuck up and nice rear angulation. Moved as one with owner

Dalmation. Liver spotted girl. Lots to like about this girl, lovely profile and sound movement.

Open 3 (2 Abs)

1st: Mrs T Pittock, Zuludawn Over Cheechako

Japanese Spitz. Stood alone, but oh my gosh, what a worthy winner! Shown in excellent condition with a super coat. Very feminine head, dark eye and correct bite. Good bone, straight front and a lovely side profile. Moved lovely in all directions.

Miniature Poodle. This classy chocolate girl immediately caught my eye and she did not disappoint when I got my hands on her. Very pretty head with a heart warming expression. Lovely front, great spring of rib, correct topline and well bent stifle. Her movement was so spot on and so in tune with her handler, who showed her to perfection. Best Veteran in Group

2nd: Mr B Chessell, Araki Areu Ready For This At Stylaxian ShCM ShCE

Tibetan Terrier. Another super quality veteran. Parti coloured Bitch with a smart feminine head. Lovely straight front, excellent spring of rib, correct topline and well angled rear. Another super mover who was as one with her handler.

Utility Group:

1st. Dalmation. Mr & Mrs Finlay, Dvojica Excuse My French At Dalfen JW

Beautiful bitch with a pleasing feminine head, full of length. Correct ear set with a moderate stop. Strong, long neck, slightly arched onto a straight front and strong pastern. Good depth of chest and nice tuck up. Level back with a strong loin. Super rear angulation and free flowing movement. What a showgirl!

2nd. Miniature Poodle.

Superbly presented, very smart and shown exceptionally well. Long, fine head and dark eye. Strong, arched neck on a straight front, strong pasterns and small feet. She had an exquisite outline and did not disappoint on the move.

Utility Puppy Group:

1st. French Bulldog. Brooks & Cairn, Corursus Become The One JW

Dark Brindle Male. This young chap oozes breed type and full of that typical Frenchie style. Lovely masculine square head with the darkest of eye, correct bite and those defining bat ears, which he used constantly. Super straight front, strong pasterns and good feet. Super feminine head with lovely dark eye. Strong neck on a straight front with great pasterns. Good spring of rib and a nice tuck up. Correct tail set and good rear anhulation. Moved really well, full of breed type.

3rd. Dalmation. Mr & Mrs Collier. Kallierbelle Ceithir

Very smart bitch, super profile and great movement.

4th. Japanese Shiba Inu. Mrs K Brennan, Burwen Billie Jean At Kaytoni

Smart bitch, very typey with good movement.

AV Special Beginners Stakes 22 (14 Abs)

1st. Miss k Moulin, Gunsyn Ginonther Rock Dei Majikisles

Bracco Italiano. Lots to like about this young bitch. She has a long, narrow head with large oval eyes, all giving her that typical soft expression. Powerful short neck on a strong front, broad chest and correct topline. Great bend of stifle giving her a powerful drive with that distinctive high carrier head.

2nd. Miss P Newman, Creamwood Silver Hawthorne

Labrador. Full of breed type and with plenty of bone. This masculine male had everything I wanted in a gundog. Strong head, great front, lovely rear angulation and he moved true from all angles.
