He has nicely balanced head proportions with a good mouth and lovely, expressive dark eye. His lip placement is good and he has well padded cheeks. He has a deep brisket with good tuck up. His topline has a gentle rise. He has well-muscled quarters with good width and adequate angulation. Moved out well to take **Best of Breed** and was pleased to here he had gone **Utility Group 1**.

2<sup>nd</sup> Warren & Jobson's **Warson's Flash Gordon** Another nice dog that pushed the winner hard. He has a pleasing head but lacked the expression of the winner. He has a good length of foreleg that balances well with his rear angles. He is balanced and moved well around the ring. **Reserve Best of Breed**
